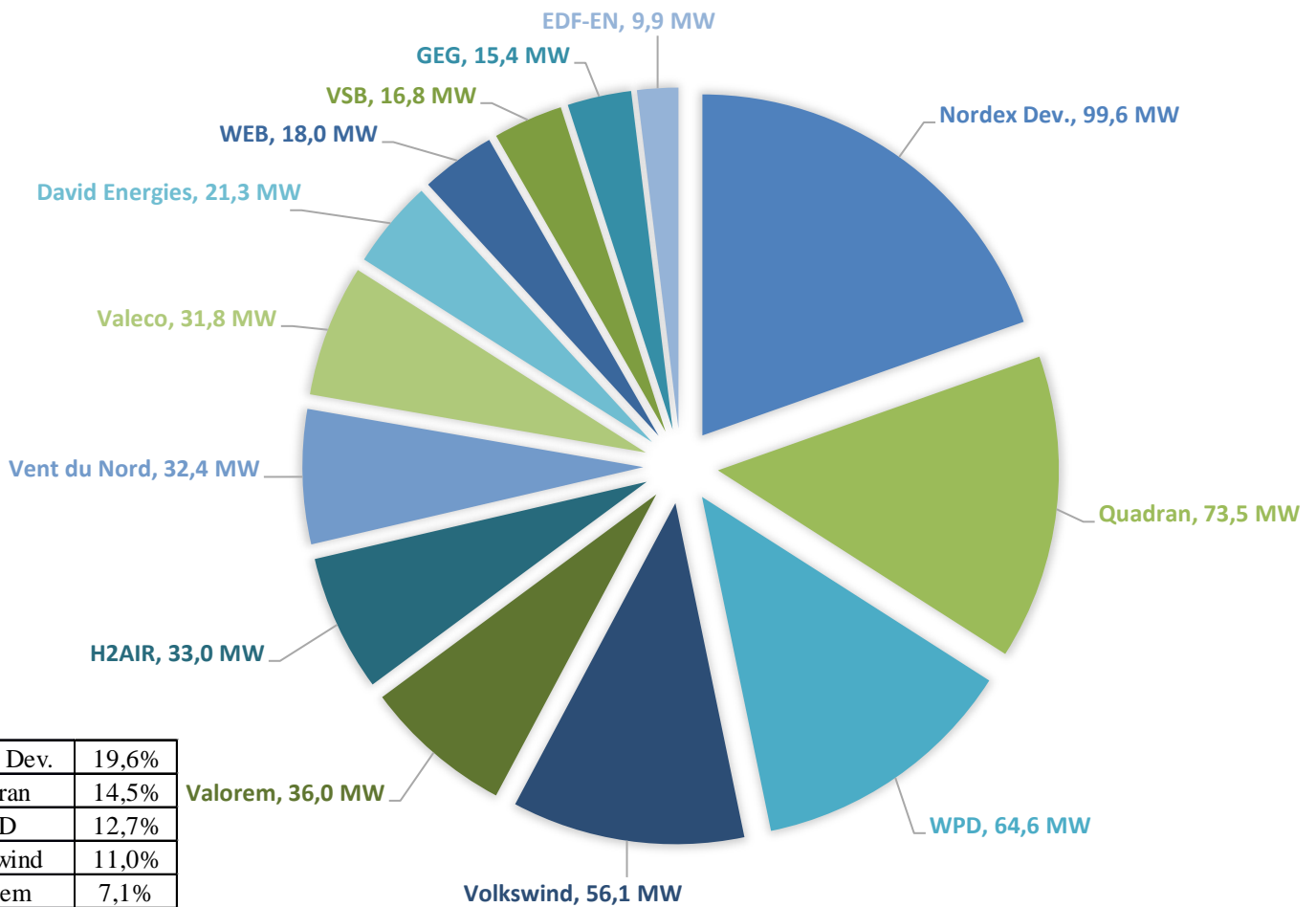


Paris, 28th February 2018
French Onshore Wind Auction, focus on results

Results of the first French wind auction have been published on 28th February 2018 and 22 projects were awarded for a cumulated power of 508,4 MW. Average price of the awarded projects is 65,4€/MWh.

For this first Auction, nearly 900 MW of project were submitted and 508 MW awarded. According to tender rules, those projects need to be constructed within the next 36 months and commissioned before 28th February 2021.

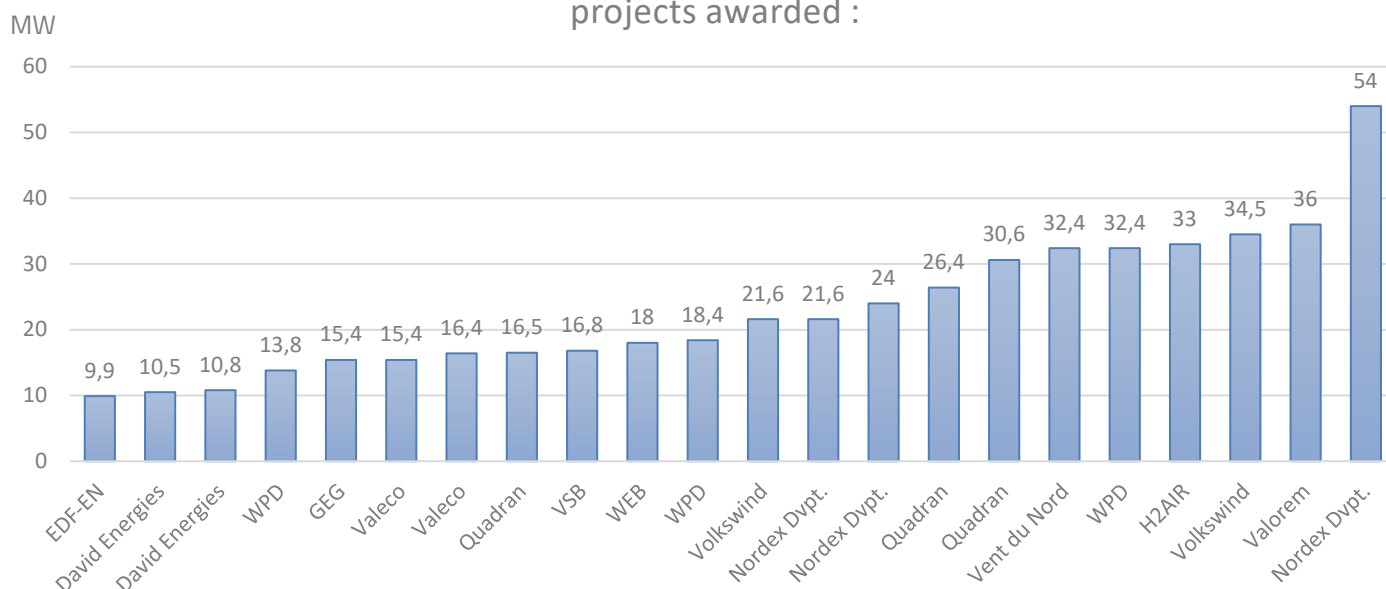
FRENCH AUCTION - MARKET SHARE



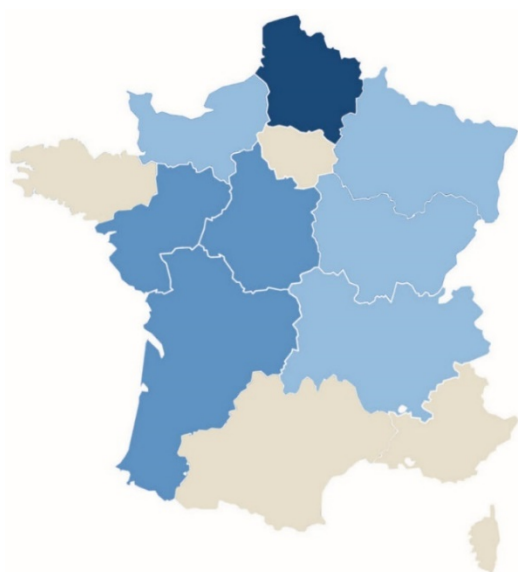

This result confirms the dynamism of the French wind market, highlighted by the 2017 1,697 MW connected to the grid (ref: fee.asso.fr) and the expected 1,800 MW for 2018 (ref: fee.asso.fr). In Europe, such a process is already in place in many other countries, but this is the first time that it was organized in France. French market confirms a strong position in the European market with a third place in 2017 (ref: windeurope.org) and a fourth European position thanks to the cumulated 13.76 GW connected in France at the end of 2017 (ref : windeurope.org).

projects awarded :



Average project size is 23 MW, 9.9 MW is the smallest, 54 MW is the largest; for a total of 22 projects.



Those projects are located in 8 regions, 44% of those projects are located in Hauts-de-France. Next auction is scheduled to start on 1st June 2018 for another 500 MW volume.
