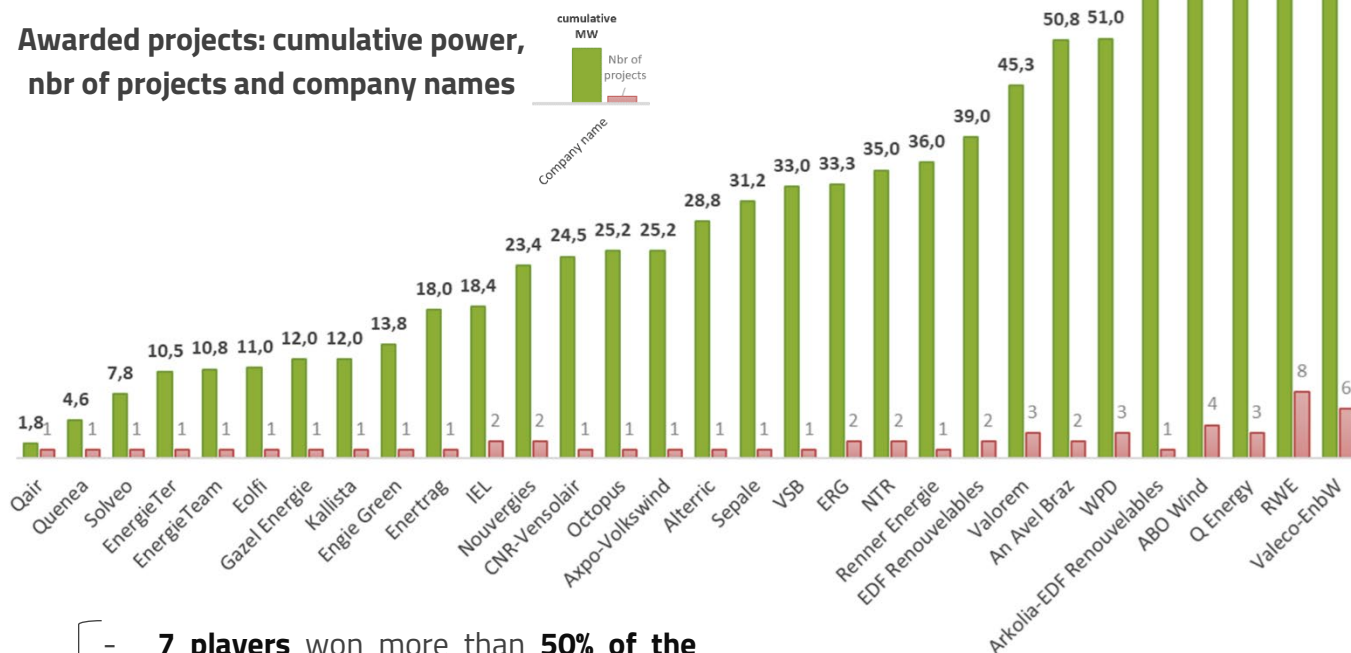


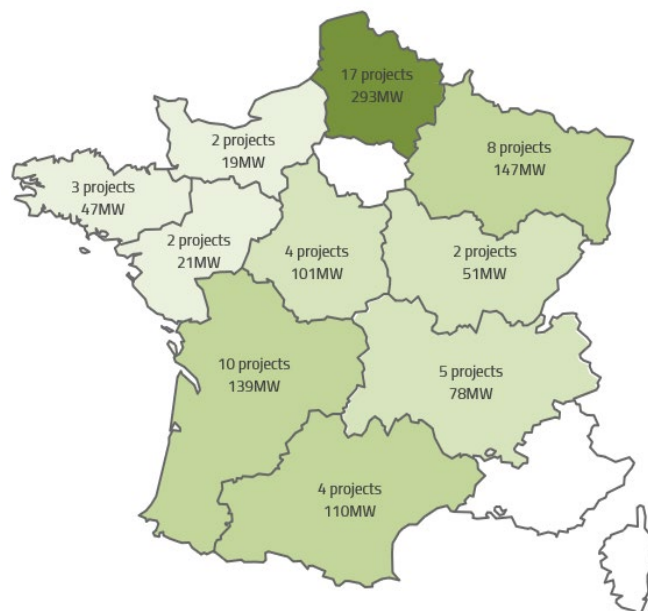
## ENVINERGY INSIGHT ON 14<sup>TH</sup> FRENCH ONSHORE WIND AUCTION

Awarded bidders have been communicated, since the 14<sup>th</sup> of February, the 14<sup>th</sup> onshore wind auction (or 6<sup>th</sup> period of PPE2). The results are the following: **57 projects** are awarded out of 93 submitted, for a total capacity of **1,006MW** out of 1,800MW submitted. The projects were awarded for an average tariff of **€87.23/MWh** (reminder of recent previous wind auctions : €84.76-Sept 23, €86.94-Dec 23 PPE2-5, €85.2-Dec 23 Neutral-2).

### Awarded projects: cumulative power, nbr of projects and company names



- **7 players** won more than **50% of the overall volume** (Valeco-EnBW, RWE, Q Energy, Abowind, Arkolia-EDF Ren., WPD and An Avel Braz)
- **30 bidders** (or teams of bidders) selected, among which **7 new players** won for the first time (Eolfi, Gazel Energie, Nouvergies, NTR, Octopus, QAir and Quenea)
- **3 regions** (Hauts de France, Grand-Est and Nouvelle-Aquitaine) **captured 57% of the volume** (with 35 projects)
- **390 MW** of the total volume (19 projects) concern projects which had **already been selected during previous auctions**
- Taking into account 14 onshore wind auctions and 2 technological neutral auctions, a total of nearly **8GW of projects have now been awarded** (avoiding double counting due to some projects that have already been selected during previous auctions)
